

Week at a Glance: The Week at a Glance at the beginning of each new week shows you what you will be working on that week, and you can then plan to slot things into your schedule. See an example below:





The Letter

- The letter a makes 3 sounds.
 - Short a sounds like cat.
 - Long **a** sounds like bake.
 - Long a is when the letter says its own name.
 - It also says the sound "ah" like car.




